






Paul's 2<sup>nd</sup> Mission Trip (Acts 15:36-18:22) 50-52AD




(Acts 17:16-18, 22) <sup>16</sup> Now while Paul waited for them at Athens, his spirit was provoked within him when he saw that the city was given over to idols. <sup>17</sup> Therefore he reasoned in the synagogue with the Jews and with the *Gentile* worshipers, and in the marketplace daily with those who happened to be there. <sup>18</sup>Then certain Epicurean and Stoic philosophers encountered him. And some said, "What does this babbler want to say?" Others said, "He seems to be a proclaimer of foreign gods," because he preached to them Jesus and the resurrection. <sup>22</sup> Then Paul stood in the midst of the Areopagus [Mars Hill] and said, "Men of Athens, I perceive that in all things you are very religious;

(Acts 19:1, 8-10)¹And it happened, while Apollos was at Corinth, that Paul, having passed through the upper regions, came to Ephesus. And finding some disciples<sup>8</sup> And he went into the synagogue and spoke boldly for three months, reasoning and persuading concerning the things of the kingdom of God. <sup>9</sup> But when some were hardened and did not believe, but spoke evil of the Way before the multitude, he departed from them and withdrew the disciples, reasoning daily in the school of Tyrannus. <sup>10</sup> And this continued for two years, so that all who dwelt in Asia heard the word of the Lord Jesus, both Jews and Greeks. (Acts 20:17, 27, 35) <sup>17</sup> From Miletus he sent to Ephesus and called for the elders of the church. <sup>27</sup> For I have not shunned to declare to you the whole counsel of God. <sup>35</sup> I have shown you in every way, by laboring like this, that you must support the weak. And remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that "He said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'

### Paul the arrestee 's 4th mission trip (Acts 21:17-28:31) 58-63AD




(Acts 25:11) "For if I am an offender, or have committed anything deserving of death, I do not object to dying; but if there is nothing in these things of which these men accuse me, no one can deliver me to them. I appeal to Caesar." (Acts 28:1, 11-13, 15-16, 30-31) Now when they had escaped, they then found out that the island was called Malta [Melita]. "After three months we sailed in an Alexandrian ship whose figurehead was the Twin Brothers [Castor and Pollux], which had wintered at the island. "And landing at Syracuse, we stayed three days. "From there we circled round and reached Rhegium. And after one day the south wind blew; and the next day we came to Puteoli, "And from there, when the brethren heard about us, they came to meet us as far as Appii Forum and Three Inns [Taverns]. When Paul saw them, he thanked God and took courage. Now when we came to Rome, the centurion delivered the prisoners to the captain of the guard; but Paul was permitted to dwell by himself with the soldier who guarded him. Then Paul dwelt two whole years in his own rented house, and received all who came to him, "I preaching the kingdom of God and teaching the things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ with all confidence, no one forbidding him.

#### After Paul's release during 64 to 65 AD from this 4th arrestee mission, Paul was imprisoned again in the Mamertine dungeon prison during 66-68 AD.

(2 Tim 4:6-8) For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure is at hand. <sup>7</sup> I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. <sup>8</sup> Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.

(Revelation 1:19-20) "Write the things which you have seen, and the things which are, and the things which will take place after this. <sup>20</sup> The mystery of the seven stars which you saw in My right hand, and the seven golden lampstands: The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands which you saw are the seven churches." In 100 miles or 175 km away from Ephesus in SW, Patmos island where John the Apostle was exiled under Domitian in 95 AD is there. (Ephesus church -loveless; Smyrna-persecuted; Pergamos-compromising; Thyatira-corrupt; Sardis-dead; Philadelphia-faithful; Laodicea-lukewarm -- the 7 churches where John likely had ministered.)

## References to the Sites



Science (the study to prove seen physical world) is a means to know sovereign God's creation and the true word of God, not an end (e.g., DNA test ancestry; "the circle of earth" in Isaiah 40:22).




