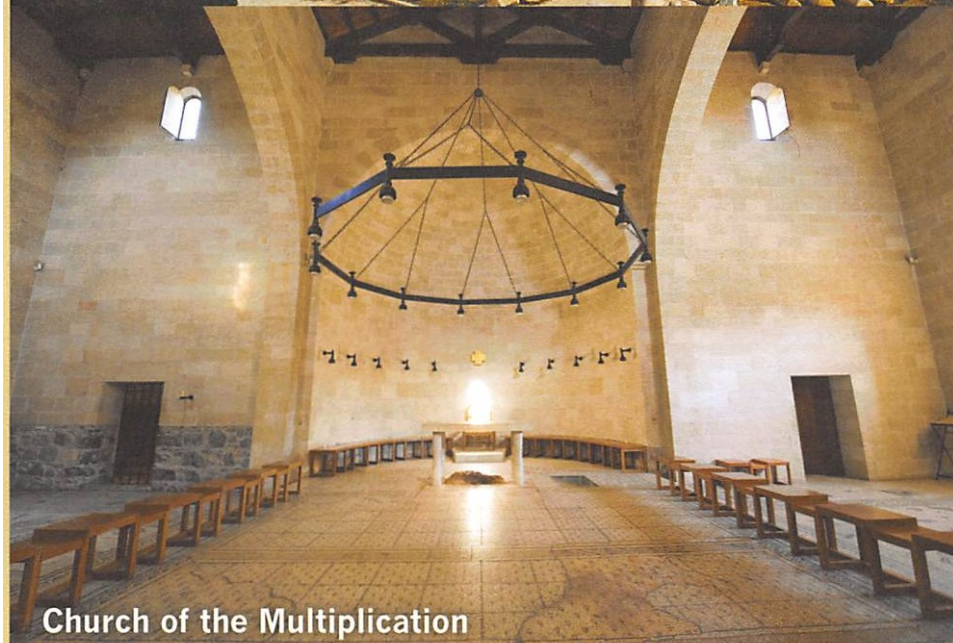

The Holy Land Experience

*Jonah 1:3*²

1. TUE, FEB 18 JFK •TEL AVIV

Depart from JFK for Tel Aviv, Israel. Meals and overnight on board. After dinner relax and enjoy the on-board entertainment. Many orthodox Jews may be seen. *Deut 6:4,5,8; Lev 13:41*¹

2. WED, FEB 19 TEL AVIV

Arrive at Tel Aviv's **Ben-Gurion Airport** at and meet our guide who will welcome us to the Land of the Bible and escort us throughout our stay in Israel. Israeli guides are legendary for their knowledge and dedication. Ours will instruct us on the many sites we will visit and their relationship to the religion, history, archaeology, culture, and modern life in Israel. Visit **Old Jaffa (Tel Aviv-Jaffa "Joppa")**, the traditional home of **Simon the Tanner** and the port from which **Jonah** sailed. Proceed to the shores of the Mediterranean in Netanya. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Netanya. *Acts 10:6*;

3. THU, FEB 20 TIBERIAS

Refreshed from a good night's sleep you may wish to stroll the beach before a full Israeli Buffet Breakfast. Today we pass through the fast growing towns and farms of the **Plain of Sharon** through **Mt Carmel 1 Kings 18:20-22**³ to **Caesarea**, where were Roman Aqueduct, Harold's Palace *Mat 2:3-4*⁴, Monument of Pontius Pilate, & site of major events in the lives of **Peter** *Acts 10:24-25*⁵ and

² *Acts 10:6* He is lodging with Simon, a tanner, whose house is by the sea. He will tell you what you must do"; *Jonah 1:3* But Jonah arose to flee to Tarshish from the presence of the Lord. He went down to Joppa, and found a ship going to Tarshish; so he paid the fare, and went down into it, to go with them to Tarshish from the presence of the Lord.

³ *1 Kings 18:20-22* So Ahab sent for all the children of Israel, and gathered the prophets together on Mount Carmel. ²¹ And Elijah came to all the people, and said, "How long will you falter between two opinions? If the LORD is God, follow Him; but if Baal, follow him." But the people answered him not a word. ²² Then Elijah said to the people, "I alone am left a prophet of the LORD; but Baal's prophets are four hundred and fifty men.

⁴ *Mat 2:3-4* When Herod the king heard this, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him. ⁴ And when he had gathered all the chief priests and scribes of the people together, he inquired of them where the Christ was to be born.

⁵ *Acts 10:24-25* And the following day they entered Caesarea. Now Cornelius was waiting for them, and had called together his relatives and close friends. ²⁵ As Peter was coming in, Cornelius met him and fell down at his feet and worshipped him.

Paul *Acts 25:13;26:1*⁶. It's on to **Megiddo** *2 Chro 35:22*⁷, inspiration for James Michener's "The Source". Archaeological digs reveal 20 layers of civilization, including fortifications of **King Solomon 1 Kings 9:15**⁸ and the water system of **King Ahab 1 Kings 18:4-5**⁹. Megiddo provides a magnificent view of the fertile **Jezeel Valley** *Joshua 17:16*¹⁰, **prophesied site of Armageddon** *Rev 16:16*¹¹, at the crossroads of the ancient **Via Maris**. Continue through the rolling hills of the **Galilee** to **Nazareth** *Mat 2:23*¹² in the sight on the

⁶ *Acts 25:13* And after some days King Agrippa and Bernice came to Caesarea to greet Festus. *26:1* Then Agrippa said to Paul, "You are permitted to speak for yourself." So Paul stretched out his hand and answered for himself:

⁷ *2 Chro 35:22* Nevertheless Josiah would not turn his face from him, but disguised himself so that he might fight with him, and did not heed the words of Necho from the mouth of God. So he came to fight in the Valley of Megiddo.

top of Mt Precipice, site of Mary's Well, and **Cana John 2:11¹³**, site of His first miracle, before arriving in **Tiberias John 6:23¹⁴**. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in **Tiberias**.

4. FRI, FEB 21 TIBERIAS

This day alone is worth the trip! We are now literally walking in the footsteps of Jesus. We will take a most memorable **boat ride on the Sea of Galilee**, in a replica of the ancient wooden boat *John 6:20-21¹⁵* used in Jesus' day. We will visit ancient boat believed to be from Jesus' time found in the Sea of Galilee in 1986. we will journey north to **Caesarea Philippi** (Baniyas Spring) *Mat 16:13¹⁶* where **Peter** confessed, "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God" (*Matthew 16:16*.) to **Mt Hermon** (Mt of Transfiguration) *Mark 9:2¹⁷* and the **Sermon on the Mount and the Mount of Beatitudes** *Mat 5:1-3¹⁸*. You will have an opportunity for a lunch of **St. Peter's fish** *Mat 4:18¹⁹* ("bass

fish" optional.) In the afternoon We walk into **Tabgha** the site of the **Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes** (5 loaves & 2 fishes) *John 6:10²⁰*, and **Capernaum** (the village of comfort) *John 6:24²¹* with the **ancient synagogue & Peter's house** *Luke 4:38²²*, and to **Magdala** *Mat 15:39²³*, and **Bethsaida** (4,000 feed) *Mat 15:34,38; 11:21²⁴*. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in **Tiberias**.

5. SAT, FEB 22 TIBERIAS• JERUSALEM

This morning we will visit, through shut shops on the Sabbath in the downtown, the **Jordan River** and have the opportunity for a **baptismal service at Yardenit** *Mat 3:16-17²⁵*. Drive along the **Jordan Valley** to **Beit She'an** *1 Sam 31:1-4²⁶* to see

were fishermen.

²⁰ *John 6:10* Then Jesus said, "Make the people sit down." Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand.

²¹ *John 6:24* when the people therefore saw that Jesus was not there, nor His disciples, they also got into boats and came to Capernaum, seeking Jesus.

²² *Luke 4:38* Now He arose from the synagogue and entered Simon's house. But Simon's wife's mother was sick with a high fever, and they made request of Him concerning her.

²³ *Mat 15:39* And He sent away the multitude, got into the boat, and came to the region of Magdala.

²⁴ *Mat 15:34,38* ³⁴ Jesus said to them, "How many loaves do you have?" And they said, "Seven, and a few little fish." ³⁸ Now those who ate were four thousand men, besides women and children; *11:21* "Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works which were done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes..

²⁵ *Mat 3:16-17* When He had been baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened to Him, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting upon Him. ¹⁷ And suddenly a voice came from heaven, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."

²⁶ *1 Sam 31:1-4* Now the Philistines fought against Israel; and the men of Israel fled from before the Philistines, and fell slain on Mount Gilboa. ² Then the Philistines followed hard after Saul and

the expansive excavations taking place at this ancient Roman Scythopolis city of **Decapolis** Region *Mark 5:16,20²⁷*. Stop at **Gideon's Spring** *Judges 7:5²⁸* where **Gideon** selected his soldiers to do battle against the Midianites. It's now time to "go up" to **Jerusalem**. We will enter the city as pilgrims did since ancient times to fulfill the words of the prophet "I was glad when they said unto me: 'Our feet shall stand within thy Gates, O Jerusalem'" (*Psalms 122:1-2*.) We will visit, through Samaria, **Bethlehem** *Luke 2:4; 2 Sam 23:15²⁹* and see **Manger Square** *Luke 2:16³⁰*, the **Church of the Nativity**, and view **Shepherds' Fields** *Luke 2:8³¹* (Shepherd's Field Church) and the **Fields of Boaz and Ruth** *Ruth 2:2-3; 4:17³²*.

his sons. And the Philistines killed Jonathan, Abinadab, and Malchishua, Saul's sons. ³ The battle became fierce against Saul. The archers hit him, and he was severely wounded by the archers. ⁴ Then Saul said to his armorbearer, "Draw your sword, and thrust me through with it, lest these uncircumcised men come and thrust me through and abuse me."

²⁷ *Mark 5:16,20¹⁶* And those who saw it told them how it happened to him *who had been* demon-possessed, and about the swine (in Gergesa?) . ²⁰ And he departed and began to proclaim in Decapolis all that Jesus had done for him; and all marveled.

²⁸ *Judges 7:5* So he brought the people down to the water. And the Lord said to Gideon, "Everyone who laps from the water with his tongue, as a dog laps, you shall set apart by himself; likewise everyone who gets down on his knees to drink."

²⁹ *Luke 2:4* Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, *2 Sam 23:15* And David said with longing, "Oh, that someone would give me a drink of the water from the well of Bethlehem, which is by the gate!"

³⁰ *Luke 2:16* And they came with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the Babe lying in a manger.

³¹ *Luke 2:8* Now there were in the same country shepherds living out in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night.

³² *Ruth 2:2-3; 4:17* So Ruth the Moabitess said to Naomi, "Please let me go to the field, and glean heads of grain after him in whose sight I may find favor."

city called Nazareth, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophets, "He shall be called a Nazarene."

¹³ *John 2:11* This beginning of signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His glory; and His disciples believed in Him.

¹⁴ *John 6:23* however, other boats came from Tiberias, near the place where they ate bread after the Lord had given thanks (Tabgha)—

¹⁵ *John 6:20-21* But He said to them, "It is I; do not be afraid." ²¹ Then they willingly received Him into the boat, and immediately the boat was at the land where they were going.

¹⁶ *Mat 16:13* When Jesus came into the region of Caesarea Philippi, He asked His disciples, saying, "Who do men say that I, the Son of Man, am?"

¹⁷ *Mark 9:2* Now after six days Jesus took Peter, James, and John, and led them up on a high mountain apart by themselves; and He was transfigured before them.

¹⁸ *Mat 5:1-3* And seeing the multitudes, He went up on a mountain, and when He was seated His disciples came to Him. ² Then He opened His mouth and taught them, saying: ³ "Blessed are the poor in spirit, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

¹⁹ *Mat 4:18* And Jesus, walking by the Sea of Galilee, saw two brothers, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they

Dinner and overnight in **Jerusalem.**

6. SUN, FEB 23 JERUSALEM

Visit the scale Model of Jerusalem as it was during the days of our Lord.

We will begin the day on to the **Temple Mount (Mt Moriah)**, where Abraham was to sacrifice Isaac. See the **Dome of the Rock** and **al-Aqsa Mosque** that now stands there, taking place through **the dung gate** at the **Western Wall** (wailing wall) and the **Southern Temple Staircase**, e.g., 2 events *Luke 19:45-46; 21:2-3*³³. Start with a magnificent view of the **Old City** from the top of the **Mt. of Olives** *Mat 24:3*³⁴. Take the "**Palm Sunday Walk**" *Mat 21:8-9*³⁵, the **Garden of Gethsemane**, *Mat 26:36*³⁶, and to the **Church of All Nations** (Gethsemane Basilica of Agony).

And she said to her, "Go, my daughter."³ Then she left, and went and gleaned in the field after the reapers. And she happened to come to the part of the field *belonging* to Boaz, who *was* of the family of Elimelech.; *4:17* Also the neighbor women gave him a name, saying, "There is a son born to Naomi." And they called his name Obed. He *is* the father of Jesse, the father of David

³³ *Luke 19:45-46* Then He went into the temple and began to drive out those who bought and sold in it, ⁴⁶ saying to them, "It is written, 'My house is a house of prayer,' but you have made it a 'den of thieves.'"; *21:2-3* and He saw also a certain poor widow putting in two mites. ³ So He said, "Truly I say to you that this poor widow has put in more than all;

³⁴ *Mat 24:3* Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, "Tell us, when will these things be? And what *will be* the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?"

³⁵ *Mat 21:8-9* And a very great multitude spread their clothes on the road; others cut down branches from the trees and spread *them* on the road.

³⁶ *Mat 26:36* Then Jesus came with them to a place called Gethsemane, and said to the disciples, "Sit here while I go and pray over there."

After lunch, we enter the **Old City** through **Damascus Gate** to the **Muslim Quarter** and walk through traditional markets to **the Stations of the Cross** in the 5th of the 14 Stations (Armenian church of our lady of spasm), and walk along the **Via Dolorosa** (The way of Cross; Jesus' cross route to Calvary) to the 4th Station **Pilate's Judgment Hall** (the Ecce Homo Arch, Convent of the Sisters of Zion) up to the 1st Station the beautiful **Church of St. Anne** (The place where Pilate condemned Jesus) *John 19:1*³⁷ and the **Pool of Bethesda**, *John 5:2*³⁸ throughout **St. Stephen's Gate** (Lions Gate) *Acts 6:5,10*³⁹ Dinner and overnight in **Jerusalem.**

7. MON, FEB 24 MASADA. DEAD SEA • QUMRAN

Depart to **Masada**, overlooking the **Dead Sea [Salt Sea]** *Numbers 34:3*⁴⁰, the lowest spot on Earth, where we ascend by cable car to visit the remnants of **Herod's Palace** and where in 73 A.D. the **Zealots** *Acts 1:13*⁴¹ made their last stand against the might of Rome. Visit **En Gedi**, fabled **Spring of David**, *1 Sam 24:1-2*⁴² and

³⁷ *John 19:1* So then Pilate took Jesus and scourged Him.

³⁸ *John 5:2* Now there is in Jerusalem by the Sheep Gate a pool, which is called in Hebrew, Bethesda, having five porches.

³⁹ *Acts 6:5,10*⁵ And the saying pleased the whole multitude. And they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and the Holy Spirit, and Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolas, a proselyte from Antioch,¹⁰ And they were not able to resist the wisdom and the Spirit by which he spoke.

⁴⁰ *Numbers 34:3* Your southern border shall be from the Wilderness of Zin along the border of Edom; then your southern border shall extend eastward to the end of the Salt Sea;

proceed to **Qumran** where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** were found in 1947. Time permitting, we will go for a swim, rather a "float", in the salted waters of the **Dead Sea.** Return to **Jerusalem** for dinner and overnight.

8. TUE, FEB 25 JERUSALEM

Drive to the **Garden Tomb** *John 19:23*⁴³. Enter **Damascus Gate** into the **Christian Quarter** Walk to the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher** at the Site of Crucifixion, Golgotha), and walk through the **Cardo**, the original Roman street and see the amazing remains of the massive wall built by **King Hezekiah**. See the important excavations (Pool of Hezekiah, connected to the Hezekiah's Tunnel from the pool of Siloam, 533 meters or 1750 feet over to the outlet of upper Gihon Spring) *2 Chro 32:3-4;30; 2 Kings 20:20*⁴⁴ with a visit to the reconstructed **Jewish Quarter..** And walk throughout the **Zion Gate** to **Mt.**

Saul had returned from following the Philistines, that it was told him, saying, "Take note! David *is* in the Wilderness of En Gedi."² Then Saul took three thousand chosen men from all Israel, and went to seek David and his men on the Rocks of the Wild Goats.

⁴³ *John 19:23* Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took His garments and made four parts, to each soldier a part, and also the tunic. Now the tunic was without seam, woven from the top in one piece.

⁴⁴ *2 Chro 32:3-4* he consulted with his leaders and commanders to stop the water from the springs which were outside the city; and they helped him. ⁴ Thus many people gathered together who stopped all the springs and the brook that ran through the land, saying, "Why should the kings of Assyria come and find much water?" ³⁰ This same Hezekiah also stopped the water outlet of Upper Gihon, and brought the water by tunnel to the west side of the City of David. Hezekiah prospered in all his works; *2 Kings 20:20*²⁰ Now the rest of the acts of Hezekiah—all his might, and how he made a pool and a tunnel and brought water into the city—are they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Zion Rev 14:1⁴⁵ to see the **Upper Room of the Last Supper** (The Coenaculum) *Luke 22:12-13⁴⁶*, **King David's tomb**, and the **House of Caiaphas** *John 18:13⁴⁷*.

Drive across the **Kidron Valley** *John 18:1; Psalm 23:4⁴⁸* to visit the **Israel Museum** where we have lunch. Dinner and overnight in **Jerusalem**. *This evening we will share in a Farewell Dinner and the presentation of a Certificate of Pilgrimage to each tour participant* .. Late this evening and after dinner we transfer to the airport. Our guide will assist us with check-in procedures.

9. WED, FEB 26 ISRAEL • JFK

Depart Tel Aviv for JFK. We arrive home today with wonderful memories of a visit to the Land of the Bible!

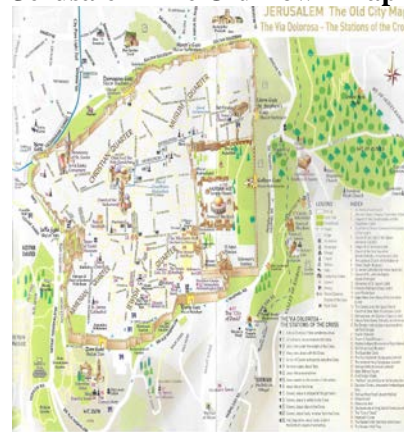

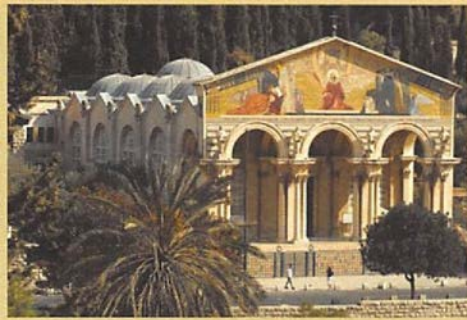

⁴⁷ John 18:13 And they led Him away to Annas first, for he was the father-in-law of Caiaphas who was high priest that year.

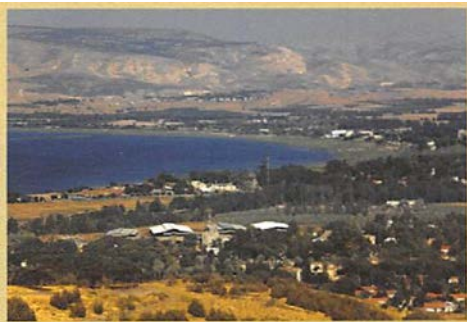
